




## PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

The PGCFJC is an initiative of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County and thereby operates under the authority of the Chief & Administrative Judge, The Honorable Sheila R. Tillerson Adams. The PGCFJC's mission and goal is carried out by the Director, who is responsible for overseeing and managing the daily operations of the organization and its staff, to include an Operation's Manager, two intake specialists, a trauma therapist, a case manager, outreach/volunteer coordinator, bi-lingual receptionist and transit operator.

The PGCFJC is an advocacy-based program. Services are offered by twenty-three (23) on site partners, to include seven government and sixteen (16) local community based organizations. The PGCFJC serves as a satellite work site for partnering organizations that provide their services as independent agencies working under interagency agreements or memorandums of understanding. Accordingly, partnering agencies are not employees of the Circuit Court. However, PGCFJC staff and its partners work as a team to coordinate and collaborate on service delivery for a seamless, efficient and efficacious service delivery system.
